

Weather Warning and Suspension of Public Transportation Services

Class cancellation policy due to weather warnings and suspension of public transportation

Weather Warning / Suspension of Transportation Services	Classes
Not in effect / Not suspended as of 7 a.m.	Start from 1 st period
Not in effect / Not suspended as of 10:30 a.m.	Start from 3 rd period
Still in effect / Not in service after 10:30 a.m.	No classes
Come into effect after classes start	The university makes a judgment depending on the situation.

◆ Target warning (more than 1 from the following)

- ① Every Emergency Warning
(Heavy rain, Storm, High tide, High wave, Blizzard and Heavy snow included)
- ② Storm ③Blizzard ④High tide ⑤Tsunami

◆ Target area

Hyogo prefecture “Kobe city” area

◆ Target transportation service (more than 1 from the following)

- ① If more than two transportation services from the followings are suspended.
JR (Osaka–Nishiakashi), Hankyu (Kobe line), Hanshin, Sanyo
- ② Rokko liner

※If emergency warning is issued while you are on campus:

If the university regards the situation as dangerous, you may not be allowed to go back home.
Follow the school staff’s instructions.

※If emergency warning is issued on the way to school:

Put your safety above all things and judge a situation independently and calmly. Stop coming to school depending on the situation

If you are late for the class due to transportation condition, make sure to get a “Late Certificate” at the station and submit it to the teacher.
