Kobe International University Japanese Language Training Program

Kobe International University (KIU) welcomes international students to our Japanese Language Training Program under an agreement with their university. This program allows the students to study at KIU for either 1 year or 1.5 year. Students who are interested in the program should consult with their home university's International Office for detailed information about this program.

1. Conditions of Application

Students who are currently studying at their university.

Students who acquired Japanese Language Proficiency Test N4 or more.

2. Application Procedure

International students who wish to apply for KIU need to submit the following documents to International Center through their home university. All documents must be in Japanese or English. If they are in other languages, please submit them with the Japanese or English translation.

- ① Application Form for International Student Exchange Program and Japanese Language Training Program (Designated form)
- ② Application Form for Certificate of Eligibility (Designated form)
- 3 Application Form for KIU's Student Accommodation (Designated form)
- 4 Health Declaration (Designated form)
- (5) Letter of Recommendation from their Home University
- 6 Transcript from their Home University
- 7 Certificate of Enrollment from their Home University
- 8 Copy of their Passport
- 9 4 Passport Pictures (40 mm x 30 mm)
- (10) Resume
- (1) Financial Statement

The financial Statement is a very important document for Certificate of Eligibility screening. Students must submit documents that will prove how they will meet the expenses while in Japan. Please submit the most recent bank statement (more than 1,500,000 yen balance for 1.5 year stay).

© Copy of their Test Result. (JLPT, J.TEST, NAT-TEST, etc.)

3. Certificate of Eligibility (CoE)

KIU will apply for the student's CoE to the Japanese Immigration Office. Once approved, CoE will be sent to the student. The student will be required to submit it to the Japanese Consulate for a student visa.

4. Schedule: Fall 2019

- ① April the end of May, 2019: Submission of the documents
- 2 June: Applying for CoE to the Immigration office
- 3 August: Result announcement
- 4 The end of August: Applying for a student visa in your country
- 5 September: Arriving in Japan

5. Accommodation

KIU provides international students with an accommodation service. Detailed information about the room is in the Application for KIU's Student Accommodation.

6. Classes

Students will be required to take Japanese conversation, Listening, Reading, Writing, and so on.
