### No Fixed Home, No Fixed Lifestyle

How would you like to move house every so often? Well, one couple has been doing this for a while. American couple David Roberts and Elaine Kuok decided to ㉑ settle in New York after living in various locations around the world. However, instead of buying their own home, they chose to live in Airbnb accommodations for a month at a time, each in a different neighborhood.

What is the couple's lifestyle like? They keep their ㉒ belongings to a minimum, filling just three suitcases between them, because everything they need for their daily lives is provided by Airbnb. David and Elaine enjoy the fact that they can experience living in different neighborhoods. David says that he likes to build up a relationship with each neighborhood. [ ㉓ ] they return and see the coffee shops they had visited before or the video shops they had browsed\* in, they feel nostalgic\*. He likens\* the experience to dating. He says, "It's almost like we've dated this person a little bit, right? And so we know these neighborhoods in a slightly different way than if [we] hadn't lived there for a month or two."

Some people may find such a lifestyle unusual, but the idea of "home" is actually changing. Vicky Richardson, an architecture expert, points out that for more and more people, "home" is where you can connect with your ㉔ online profile. It is no longer a ㉕ physical place with material objects. The Internet has changed the way we work, but will it change the way we live, too? It might become normal to live like [ ㉖ ] in the near future.
