Solar power

Solar power is a top priority for the Japanese government. Recently, it has been spending large amounts of money on solar power technology. One of the reasons for the emphasis on solar power was the nuclear accident in Fukushima in 2011. After the accident, many nuclear power stations were shut down because people were worried about safety.

(a) Consequently, there was an energy shortage and Japan had to import massive amounts of oil.

Companies in Japan and around the world are developing new solar power projects. For example, several companies have been [©] floating solar power plants. In a prefecture near Tokyo, a massive floating solar power plant has been built on a reservoir*. <u>alt</u> can generate enough electricity to supply 5,000 houses. The advantage of this type of plant is that it uses space that would otherwise be unused. In Japan, where space is limited, this is a big advantage. In the United Kingdom, a project using the same technology is going ahead on a reservoir near Manchester. When it is finished, it will be the largest solar power plant in Europe and the second largest in the world, after Japan.
