## Creating an Icon\*: Mickey Mouse

In the final scene of this cartoon character's debut\*, he throws a potato at a parrot, smacking\* the parrot in the face. The character's rude behavior offended parents. Letters from the parents reached the artist, Walt, who then incorporated\* their criticisms into later stories. Walt transformed his character's mischievous\* ways and created a politer, kinder character that kids could look up to. In addition, the character's long, rat-like tail was shortened and his eyes were enlarged, evolving into the figure known around the world.

Mickey Mouse debuted\* in *Steamboat Willie* in 1928. This seven-minute animated movie not only introduced Mickey, <u>ait</u> also used synchronized\* sound for the first time. Synchronized sound matches the onscreen images to the soundtrack.

A second charming character appeared in the film, Minnie Mouse. After plucking\* Minnie from a riverbank with a crane, Mickey played music for her, marking the start of their relationship. And if you're wondering, Mickey and Minnie are married, though their wedding hasn't appeared in any animations. Walt said they got married "in private life."

There is some mystery as to how Walt Disney and his partner, Ub Iwerks, chose the name Mickey. The men originally named the mouse Mortimer. One story contends that Walt's wife suggested the name Mickey instead; a second story claims Mickey's name came from a toy. However the duo came up with the name, they had created an icon.
